



OVERNIGHT CHECKLIST

What We Provide:

- o Transportation to and from the river
- o All necessary equipment, including tents, life jackets, helmets, paddles, certified guide, tarps, portable toilet etc.
- o All meals, lunch the first day through lunch the last day of the rafting trip
- o Dry bags will be provided to keep your personal gear from being wet. Bags will be transported to and from the camping area for your convenience.

What you need to bring:

- o any necessary prescription medications!
- o sleeping bag
- o sleeping pad
- o flashlight
- o long pants
- o pair of shorts
- o long and short sleeve t-shirt
- o camp shoes and socks
- o sweater and/or jacket
- o personal toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste etc.)
- o rain gear
- o sunscreen
- o bug repellent
- o sunglasses with retaining strap
- o hat or visor
- o waterproof, inexpensive camera and film (waterproof and disposable cameras are available in our store!)
- o clothes for the second day on the river. River clothes from the day before may not be dry before departing for the second day

There is no running water or facilities on the river bank – Camping is primitive!
